

#### 1.1 The witches meet

#### **Audience**

Opening of the play – know about Macbeth from the past popular history. 7<sup>th</sup> August 1606

Previous plays seen: Lear, Measure for Measure, Hamlet

What happened before opening performance – Trial of Guy Fawkes, First Union Flag under James, First Charter of Virginia is adopted.

### Setting

Location: Heath, neither forest nor farmland – liminal space – common land

**Conditions:** Thunder and lightning - a storm

**Time:** no clear time although they plan to meet *That will be ere the set of sun* next time.

**Space:** outdoors, nature, pre-human, elemental

# Character

**Status**: third witch has the most power *There to meet with Macbeth.* 

**See:** they see different versions of themselves

**Envy**: legitimate power

**Predicament**: want to control the world/all they can do is advise characters

**Stakes:** need to gain legitimacy/power/audience/belief **Identity/unidentity**: wise women/outcast witches

## Language

Pre scene: one with their cat, one with their frog

Under poem: sun/place/heath/Macbeth - grid coordinates for 1.3

**Pronoun:** we/I that's it – three characters acting as one

**lambic**: irregular in the first two lines 7 and then 8 - last line has the most **Hear**: the couplets at the beginning and the air – look to the threes/trinity

# **Impact**

See: three witches

Remind: witch hunts, evil, super natural

Think: what is the play going to be about, what will their role be, other plays they have seen with witches

Feel: excited, thrilled, frightened, concerned

**React:** want to know how they are going to interact with the characters in the play.
