

1.5 We meet Lady Macbeth

Audience

They know he is going to meet his wife **What** will he tell her? How will she react? **Who** else will be at his castle? **Where** will they meet in the castle?

Setting

Location: Macbeth's castle in Inverness – 26 miles from Forres

Conditions: Inside the castle

Time: Daytime as the next scene states torches *ignorant present* 57 How long does it take Macbeth to get from Forres? Bear in mind Duncan's comments in 1.6 *he rides well,/And his great love, sharp*

as his spur, hath holp him/To his home before us. 22:24

Space: Private space and she is alone

Character

Status: Macbeth, Lady Macbeth and messenger

See: Lady Macbeth – letter, *Great Glamis, worthy Cawdor*. Macbeth – *his dearest love* **Envy:** Lady Macbeth – her husband's gender, Macbeth – his wife's role in their life

Predicament: Lady Macbeth - to kill Duncan/imagine not being fertile woman, Macbeth - ignore his

wife/reassure her we will speak further

Stakes: Lady Macbeth – lucidity to plan the murder of Duncan, Macbeth – an alternative to her

suggestion

Identity/unidentity: Lady Macbeth - Caring wife/ calculating person Macbeth Loving

husband/doubting subject

Language 38:54

Pre-scene: when did Macbeth write the letter, is this the first time Lady Macbeth has read it? **Under poem:** blood/remorse/nature/between/breasts clearly foreshadowing the future in an instant

Pronoun: uses my 6 times in the soliloquy

lambic: And take my milk for gall, you murdering ministers, 48 why does it have 13 syllables **Hear:** This is the first soliloquy in the play the others are asides – why? *Come, Come, Come* – who

else appears/speak in triplets? Don't forget her speech at the end of the scene...

Impact

See: woman on stage (played by a man) reading a letter who doesn't want to be fertile, the Macbeths for the first time.

Remind: their own marriages, their own positions in society, their own desires

Think: how will this couple act after the news, will he listen to her?

Feel: excited to see the couple together curious to know what will happen next

React: eagar to see the plan in action and horrified that they are eager to see a King killed
