



1.7 The plan to murder the King

Audience

Will they see Macbeth and Lady Macbeth together in the next scene?

What are Duncan and Banquo going to do

Who else will we meet in the scene

Where are we going to see them in the castle, if we are going inside the Castle

Setting

Location: Within the castle walls and outside of the room where the banquet is happening as we see a Sewer (a servant in charge of the food preparations) and several Servants. A corridor or ante:room

Conditions: It's dark as there are torches and noisy with Hautboys (musical instruments)

Time: Early evening

Space: Public space where people enter and exit at their free will

Character

Status: Macbeth, Lady Macbeth

See: Macbeth sees his wife coming out of the banquet. Lady Macbeth sees her husband standing alone in the corridor

Envy: Macbeth envies his wife's determination, Lady Macbeth envies his conscience

Predicament: Macbeth wants to stop this happening/he has to listen to his wife. Lady Macbeth wants Macbeth back in the party/all she can do is persuade him to leave the corridor

Stakes: Macbeth conscience, Lady Macbeth her husband's commitment

Identity/unidentity: Macbeth welcoming host/confused husband, Lady Macbeth generous hostess/manipulating wife *false face must hide what false heart doth know : 83*

Language

Pre-scene: Do take care to look at the monologue of Macbeth – this is his first soliloquy

Under poem: know/me/face/gums/sworn/this 54:59 she would destroy her own image

Pronoun: *You* – 5 times and their dead son *his* once on line 57

Iambic: regular powerful rhythm. Line 47 and 59 only 4 syllables but shared with Macbeth

Hear: Macbeth and Lady Macbeth finish each other's lines 29,30, 35, 45, 59, 73, 78, 80. 78 has 12 syllables

Impact

See: Macbeth taking time out from the banquet and then they see his wife coming to look for him

Remind: when we need a bit of time out of the situation we are in and when we need someone to take charge

Think: who is in control of this marriage, this household, this story?

Feel: if no one is in control, who is control of the story at this point, do we panic

React: we want someone to be in control who are we backing at this point?
